ITINERARY DAY 2

FULL-DAY OSAKA CITY TOUR

Today, discover Osaka's spiritual side with a visit to Shitenno-ji Temple, Japan's oldest, founded in 593 by Prince Shotoku.

Enjoy a street food tour in Dotonbori at lunch, sampling local favorites like Takoyaki.

In the afternoon, explore historic Osaka Castle, originally built in the 16th century and rebuilt several times.

Travel by bullet train.

This evening, enjoy a welcome dinner near the hotel.

ITINERARY DAY 3

TRAVEL TO HIROSHIMA & MIYAJIMA

After breakfast, we'll depart with our guide on a comfortable two-hour bullet train ride to Hiroshima, passing through some of Japan's picturesque countryside along the way. We'll visit Miyajima Island, one of Japan's most iconic and picturesque destinations. A short train and ferry ride will take you to this tranquil island, known for its natural beauty and spiritual significance.

Then, we go to the renowned Itsukushima Shrine, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its "floating" torii gate, which appears to rise from the sea during high tide. In the afternoon, return by ferry to the mainland and visit the Peace Memorial Park

DAY 4

TRANSFER TO KYOTO

This morning we'll transfer to Kyoto by bullet train. We'll visit Fushimi Inari shrine and Daigo-ji in southeastern Kyoto. Fushimi Inari is known for its rows of vermilion torii gates that snake their way up the mountain from the street level shrine to the upper sanctuary. The gates are left by devotees in gratitude or to seek the good graces of the titular spirit of this Shinto shrine. As the fox or Inari is associated with rice production and rice products.

In the evening, enjoy walking in Gion, Kyoto's geisha district and there is the possibility of seeing a geiko (fully-fledged geisha) or maiko (apprentice geisha) making their way through the narrow streets. The guide can make suggestions of places to dine nearby.

ITINERARY DAY 5

VISIT KINKAKU-JI & ARASHIYAMA

Today we head to Arashiyama, a beautiful area in northwest Kyoto known for forested mountains and Togetsu-kyo Bridge over the Katsura River to visit the famous bamboo groves.

And then, we'll go to the extraordinary 14th-century Kinkaku-ji, or Golden Pavilion - named for its top two stories covered entirely in gold leaf. Nestled in the northern hills of Kyoto, this iconic Zen Buddhist temple offers breathtaking views of its shimmering reflection in the mirror-like pond below. Explore the meticulously landscaped strolling gardens, designed to evoke harmony and contemplation in every season.

In the late afternoon, take some free time for sightseeing.

ITINERARY DAY 6

STAYING AT BUDDHIST TEMPLE IN KOYASAN

We will travel by train and then along the scenic Nankai Railway Line to Koyasan, a bowl-shaped valley filled with cedars high in the mountains of the Kii Peninsula. Since the 9th century Koyasan has been a place of religious devotion and ceremony. Today there are more than 100 monasteries, many of which have Shukubo (Pilgrims lodging).

We will visit Kongobu-ji temple and there will be the vast Okuno-in cemetery, with thousands of graves and memorials to feudal lords and other past luminaries. We stay in one of the temples and dine on shojin-ryori (Buddhist vegetarian cuisine).

DAY 7

**TRAIN JOURNEY TO NARA & HIKE UP
MOUNT WAKAKUSA**

This morning, we'll depart Koyasan and travel by train to Nara. Hike up Mount Wakakusa; this is a gentle, grassy trail around 4km to hike. The trail offers encounters with the park's wild deer and culminates in panoramic views of Nara City and UNESCO World Heritage sites at the foothills to the vast Yamato Basin stretching below the summit, each part presenting a unique atmosphere.

This course starts from the mountain top and descends through a serene, dense primeval forest, serving as a familiar gateway to Nara's rich heritage and natural beauty.

After the hike we visit Nara Park to enjoy its famous freely roaming deer.

Accommodation: Iroha Grand Nara 4 or similar*



ITINERARY DAY 8

VISIT YUDANAKA, SNOW MONKEYS OF JIGOKUDANI

Early in the morning, we make the long journey to Yudanaka Onsen by express trains, a hot spring village famous for its 'snow monkeys'. The Japanese macaques originally came here to warm themselves in the outdoor hot spring bath during the cold winters, and now come all year round (weather permitting). A local lodge owner built them their own bath during the cold winters, and were subsequently made famous after being featured by Life Magazine.

Then, we can take a rest by wonderful Onsen ryokan. You can experience the Onsen Hot Spring in this beautiful Ryokan.

Accommodation: Yudanaka Yorozuya or similar



ITINERARY DAY 9

SIGHTSEEING TOKYO, HARAJUKU/SHIBUYA

Today we travel by train to Tokyo and explore Harajuku and Shibuya, one of the meccas for anime culture, fashion, and youth trends.

We'll stroll through Takeshita Street, known for its colorful shops and cosplay boutiques, and visit iconic spots like the Shibuya Crossing.

It is the perfect day to immerse in the heart of modern Japanese pop culture.

ITINERARY DAY 10

DAY TOUR IN HAKONE, VIEW OF MT FUJI

Today we travel from Tokyo to Hakone by the scenic train 'Romance car'. We'll enjoy the many highlights of the Hakone and Lake Ashi region such as the open-air museum, scenic ropeway which on a clear day has commanding views of Mount Fuji depending on weather.

Also, if weather and time allows, we can enjoy a cruise around Lake Ashi to further drink in the sights of Mount Fuji. In case of bad weather, an alternative activity will be arranged, such as a visit to the Hakone Checkpoint Museum or another indoor cultural site.

DAY 11

**TRAVEL TO HITSUJIYAMA,
CHICHIBU**

Today we travel to Chichibu Shrine by train, a historic Shinto shrine located in Chichibu, Saitama. It is over 2,000 years old and known for its beautiful carvings and traditional architecture. The shrine is also one of the main sites of the Chichibu Night Festival, a UNESCO-recognized event held every December, featuring ornate floats and lively celebrations.

After lunch, we go to Hitsujiyama Park, which may feature moss phlox in bloom depending in season. It creates a breathtaking landscape of vibrant colors and blending harmoniously with the surrounding nature.

DAY 12

TOKYO IMPERIAL PALACE - DINNER

In the morning, we visit Tokyo Imperial Palace, offering a layered experience from scenic outer gardens to historical remnants of Edo Castle to curated guided tours of restricted inner grounds. It blends tranquil green spaces with centuries of Japanese royal and cultural heritage.

Optional: Kanukiza performance

In the afternoon as an option, we'll experience a traditional Japanese performing show in Kabukiza Theatre, known for dramatic storytelling, elaborate costumes, and rich cultural music.

DAY 13

FREE DAY IN TOKYO

A full day at leisure for shopping (ex Odaiba), parks (ex Disneyland), or optional tours (ex Hike).

Optional: Mount Komagatake Hike: The trail starts at Owakudani Station on the Hakone Ropeway. Trek to the peak of the 1,438-meter Mount Kamiyama, the highest point in Hakone for beautiful views of Lake Ashinoko, Suruga Bay and Mount Fuji. Descend via the Hakone Komagatake Ropeway, which takes you to Hakone-en Station.

Optional: Sumo Wrestling (if available)
Experience the thrill of Japan's ancient national sport with a live sumo wrestling match. This unforgettable excursion includes expert insights into the rituals, history, and culture behind sumo's dramatic battles.

ITINERARY DAY 14

FINAL LEISURE DAY IN TOKYO BEFORE YOUR DEPARTURE OR EXTEND TO OKINAWA

On your free day in Tokyo, visit the icon Hachikō statue or relax at Meiji Shrine. Foodies can enjoy sushi at Tsukiji Market or discover themed cafés. For pop culture, head to Akihabara's anime shops and arcades.

At approximately 9pm, you'll depart for Haneda Airport. Arigatō!

or if you want a complete tour of Japan you can extend your stay to Okinawa! Transfer to the airport for your 2.40hrs flight to the paradise islands of Japan. Once you arrive, catch the Ferry to Zamami Island. You can enjoy your first dip in the turquoise waters of the Kerama Islands, which are considered a national park with clear blue waters and excellent snorkelling and diving opportunities.

EXPLORING ZAMAMI ISLAND



Good morning from Zamami. Spend the day unwinding on Zamami Island, where powdery white beaches and turquoise waters invite you to swim, snorkel, or simply stretch out and relax under the sun. Take a stroll through the laid-back village, stop by a local café for a light Okinawan lunch, and if you're up for adventure, hop on a kayak or join a boat trip in search of sea turtles. As the afternoon cools, make your way up to the Takatsuki Observatory, where sweeping views of the Kerama Islands set the stage for a breathtaking sunset, painting the sky in shades of orange and pink – the perfect ending to an island escape

**EXPLORING ZAMAMI ISLAND &
TRANSFER TO OKINAWA**

Today after breakfast you will check out. Then you will go to explokre Ama Beach, as you walk and enjoy swimming and snorkeling in this paradise beach.

Then you will catch the afternoon ferry to Naha in Okinawa.

Visit Peace Memorial Park, a beautiful open space honoring those who fought in the WWII battle of Okinawa. After this you will be transferred to Gyokusendo Cave . Discovered in 1967, this soaring underground cave has over a million stalactites & pools of water.

DAY 17

EXPLORING OKINAWA

Start your Okinawa adventure by heading north along the coast to Cape Manzamo, where the dramatic elephant trunk-shaped cliffs meet turquoise seas – the perfect place for a breezy walk and some epic photos. From there, continue up the coast to Emerald Beach, a postcard-perfect spot inside Ocean Expo Park, where you can dip your toes in crystal-clear water, relax on the sand, with ocean views.

After soaking up the sun, cross the stunning Kouri Bridge to Kouri Island, famous for its white-sand beaches and chilled island vibe. Spend the afternoon exploring cozy seaside cafés, snapping photos at the Heart Rock, or circling the island for panoramic viewpoints like the Kouri Ocean Tower.

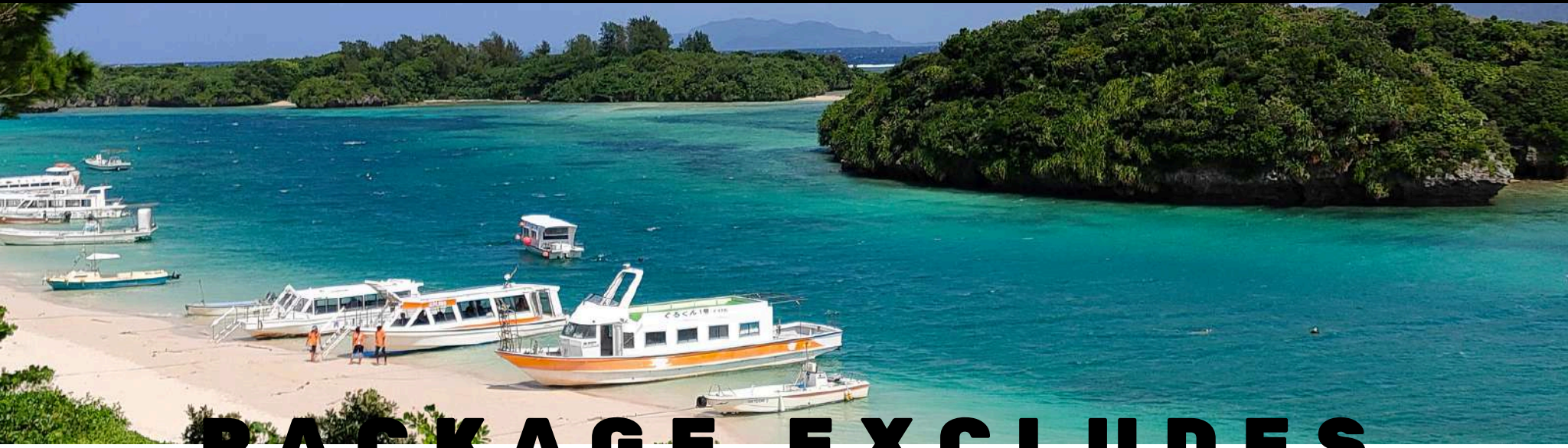

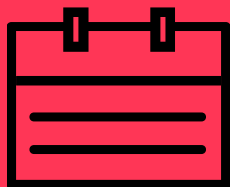
